What to Ask Your Healthcare Professional or Pharmacist

- What is the medication's name?
- What is the medication for?
- How much do I take? How often?
- Do I take it with food or drink?
- What food/drinks/activities to avoid?
- Will it react with other drugs/herbs?
- What are the possible side effects?
- What if I miss a dose?
- For how long do I take it?
- When should I talk to you if my symptoms don't change?
- Are generic forms available?
- Can the prescription be refilled?

Manage Your Medications

- Know what you are taking and why.
- Follow all label directions.
- Record all your medications and when you take them, including over-the-counter drugs and herbs.
- Tell your healthcare professional about any side effects or concerns.
- Throw out medications that have expired.
- Never take others' prescription drugs.
- Never keep medications in the bathroom. Follow directions for storage.
- Consult your healthcare professional before you stop taking any prescriptions, or change dosages.
